



# First Lego League Robotics Teams Forming for 2019-2020!

Are you an upcoming 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grader interested in Lego Robotics? Teams are forming now for next year's season.

Challenge School Lego Robotics teams meet during Mini-Course 1 (6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> graders only) AND Mini-Course 2 (5<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> graders). Teams practice on Tuesdays from 3:00-5:30PM, and the cost per student is \$100 per student.

Students participate in [First Lego League](#) which challenges teams to build and program a Lego robot to complete tasks on a field. The tasks are centered on a theme (next year's hasn't been released yet). Teams also research the theme, identify a problem, develop a solution, and communicate that solution to the community. These challenges, as well as the challenge of working as a team, make for an exciting season culminating in a tournament where teams compete and present their learning to judges.
